Mathilde: **Bonjour!**

Emma: **Salut!**

Mathilde: **Bienvenue à High Five French.**

Emma: Welcome to High Five French. My name is Emma. **Je m'appelle Emma.**

Mathilde: **Moi, c'est Mathilde.**

Emma: Mathilde is helping me learn some French.

Mathilde: So, what do you want to learn today, Emma?

Emma: I would quite like to learn about names. I already know how to say "my name is

Emma"; **je m'appelle** Emma. Let's practise:

je m'appelle Emma.

Mathilde: **Je m'appelle Mathilde. Je m'appelle...**

[You try!] **Bien!**

Emma: If I can say "my name is..." then I need to be able to say "what is your name?"

Mathilde: What is your name **en français est comment t'appelles-tu?**

Emma: **Comment t'appelles-tu?**

Mathilde: **Comment t'appelles-tu?** [You try!] Let's practise. **Comment t'appelles-tu?**

Emma: **Je m'appelle Emma. Comment t'appelles-tu?**

Mathilde: **Je m'appelle Mathilde.** You also say, **moi, c'est** Mathilde.

Emma: **Moi, c'est** Emma. **C'est facile.**

Mathilde: **Je te l'avais dit.** I told you so.

Emma: Now, there are two more words I want to know in French. One is "please" and the other is "thank you" because, it's nice to be polite.

Mathilde: "Please" in French is **s'il te plaît.**

Emma: **S'il te plaît.**

Mathilde: **Bravo! S'il te plaît** [you try!]. Good! And "thank you" is **merci.**

Emma: **Merci.**

Mathilde: **Merci.** [You try!] Good! **Et maintenant, le test!**

Emma: Mathilde is now going to test us on the words we've learned today!
