Sophie: **¿Cómo te llamas?**

Miguel: **Me llamo Miguel. ¿Y tú? ¿Cómo te llamas?**

Sophie: **Me llamo Sophie.**

Sophie: What was that thing before **¿cómo te llamas?**

Miguel: **¿Y tú?** It means "and you?" or "what about you?" **¿Y tú?**

Here Miguel is referring to the differences in pronunciation around the Spanish-speaking world. In some places **gracias** is pronounced with the -s- sound, while in most parts of Spain it's pronounced as -th-.
